In 2003, based on feedback from our citizens concerning the most important results that we need to achieve, the City established a long-range plan that included five goals. Over the last four years our administration has delivered on each of these key priorities which are that:

- People will say Denver is an even better place to live
- Denver will grow a vital economy
- Denver City Government will achieve the highest customer service rating in the country
- People who work for Denver city government will say it is an even better place to work
- Denver City government will live within its means

Our long-term goals also include Denver's Road Home, our 10-year-plan to end homelessness, and Greenprint Denver in which every City agency has committed to reduce consumption of energy. In addition, the Denver community has committed to reducing energy consumption and Denver's recycling has increased by 63%. The Denver community has planted more than 65-thousand trees in our effort to expand the urban forest, one of the largest, if not the largest in the history of this country. The key to Denver's success is citizen participation and continued cooperation and collaboration with our regional neighbors.

This year Denver will celebrate our sesquicentennial - 150th - birthday. For the first time in a hundred years, we will host the convention of one of our national political parties. And in 2010, we will host the world's first Biennial of the Americas - to celebrate the contemporary arts, cultures, and emerging creative thoughts of the Western Hemispheres.

Denver has succeeded in creating a great city - we are changing the world.
