**Newly elected Councilman releases 100 Day Report; Video update  
Reflects on first 100 days in office**

DENVER, CO. –October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Albus Brooks, the newly elected councilman for Denver’s most diverse council district, has released a comprehensive report of his first 100 days in office. “I want to let residents of this great city know what I have been up to, and how their tax dollars are being spent,” he said. The report outlines the accomplishments from the first 100 days in office, provides some insight to the daily operations of the District 8 council office, and gives an honest assessment of what remains to be done.

“Unlike politicians full of empty promises, who come around only during election time, Councilman Brooks is accessible, responsive, and engaged,” says community leader Brother Jeff Fard. “A man of his word, Brooks typifies bold, forward-thinking leadership.”

“I am pleasantly surprised at how Albus has been able to strike the right balance between community development, and economic development,” says Mayor Michael Hancock. “He has a lot to offer our city, and I am excited to work with him in the days and years to come.”

Brooks was particularly active during his first three months in office; from starting a non-profit organization called Engage 8, to kicking off a district-wide “Imagin8 Tour” to hear ideas. Brooks has focused on delivering on campaign promises; he started the District 8 Running Club, is currently developing a District 8 Cookbook, and has been visiting at least one school per week.

“Even though we have accomplished a ton in the first 100 days, I feel like I am barely getting started. My hunger to build a better district comes from my desire to create a community where my wife and kids will be able to thrive.” –Councilman Brooks
